## MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM – KANATA NORTH

Weekly report – April 6<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025

### *MONITORING and WEATHER*

---

**Accumulation of water:** total of 20,6 mm of rain and 16,8 cm of snow.

Date of precipitation: 8 days of precipitations have been reported since April 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Is there presence of larvae on the field?:** Yes  No

**Note:** The hatching of spring larvae is well underway. Larval development levels progress in different environments (faster in hotspots and slower in colder sites). The team will continue their sites inspections this week.
