## MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM – KANATA NORTH

Weekly report – April 20<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025

### *MONITORING and WEATHER*

---

**Accumulation of water:** A total of 14,6 mm of rainfall this week.

Date of precipitation: April 21<sup>st</sup>, April 24<sup>th</sup>, April 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Is there presence of larvae on the field?:** Yes  No

**Note:** Spring larval hatching is complete at most hotspot sites. Development in colder environments has been slower this week due to weather conditions, but additional hatching is still occurring.
