MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM – KANATA NORTH

Weekly report – April 27th to May 3rd, 2025

MONITORING and WEATHER

Accumulation of water: A total of 18,3 mm of rainfall this week.

Date of precipitation: April 27th, April 29th, May 1st, May 2nd.

Is there presence of larvae on the field?: Yes No

Note: The progression of larvae was observed in most cold environments where hatching hadn't begun by the previous week. Currently, low water levels in the Carp River appear to be delaying hatching in many areas, though some sections show significant larval progression.

Was there a treatment?: Yes No

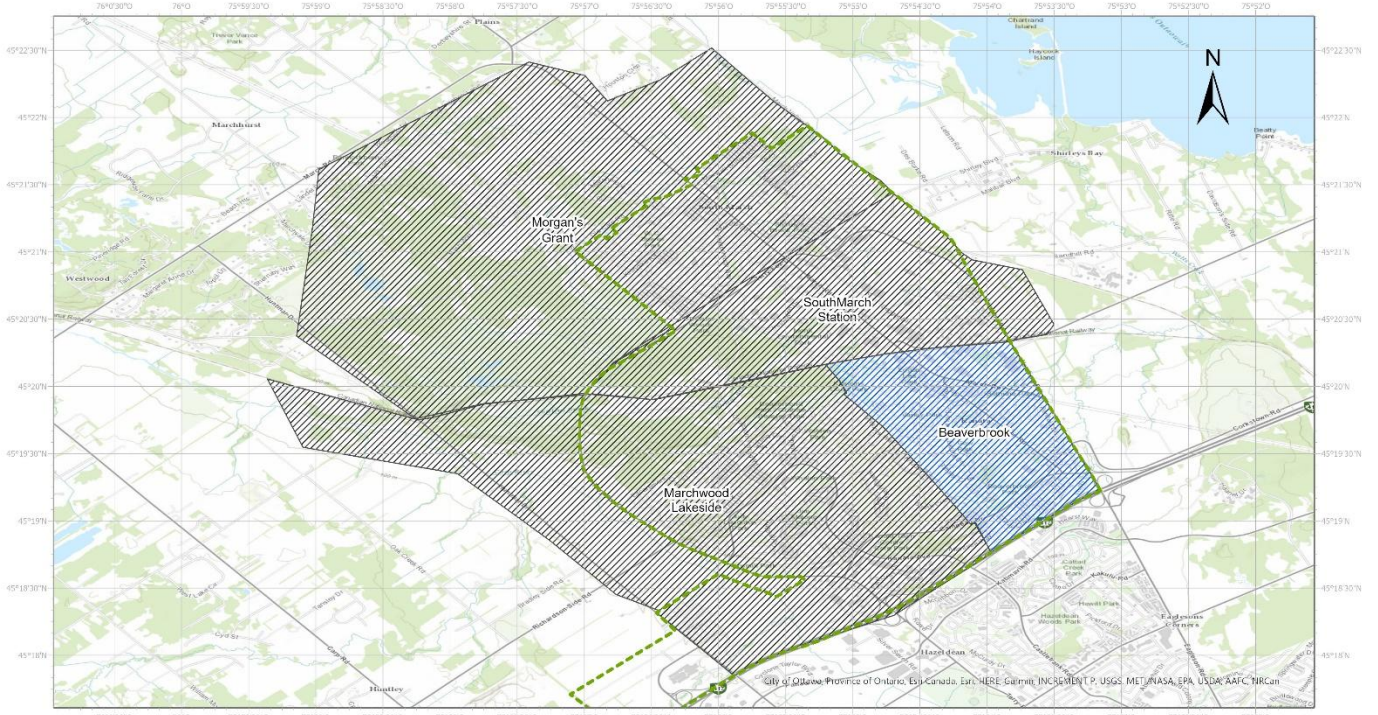
Type of treatment: Ground Aerial
