MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM – KANATA NORTH

Weekly report – July 5 to July 11, 2026

MONITORING and WEATHER

Accumulation of water: Between 15 and 27 mm of rain was observed during this period.

Date of precipitation: July 9.

Is there presence of larvae on the field?: Yes ☒ No ☐

Note: Additional rainfall this week had a negligible impact on larval habitats in Kanata North. Because most of these breeding sites remained inundated, they did not undergo the drying phase required for the oviposition (egg-laying) and subsequent hatching of floodwater mosquito species.

Additionally, while the Carp River has receded significantly from last week's peak, water levels remain high.

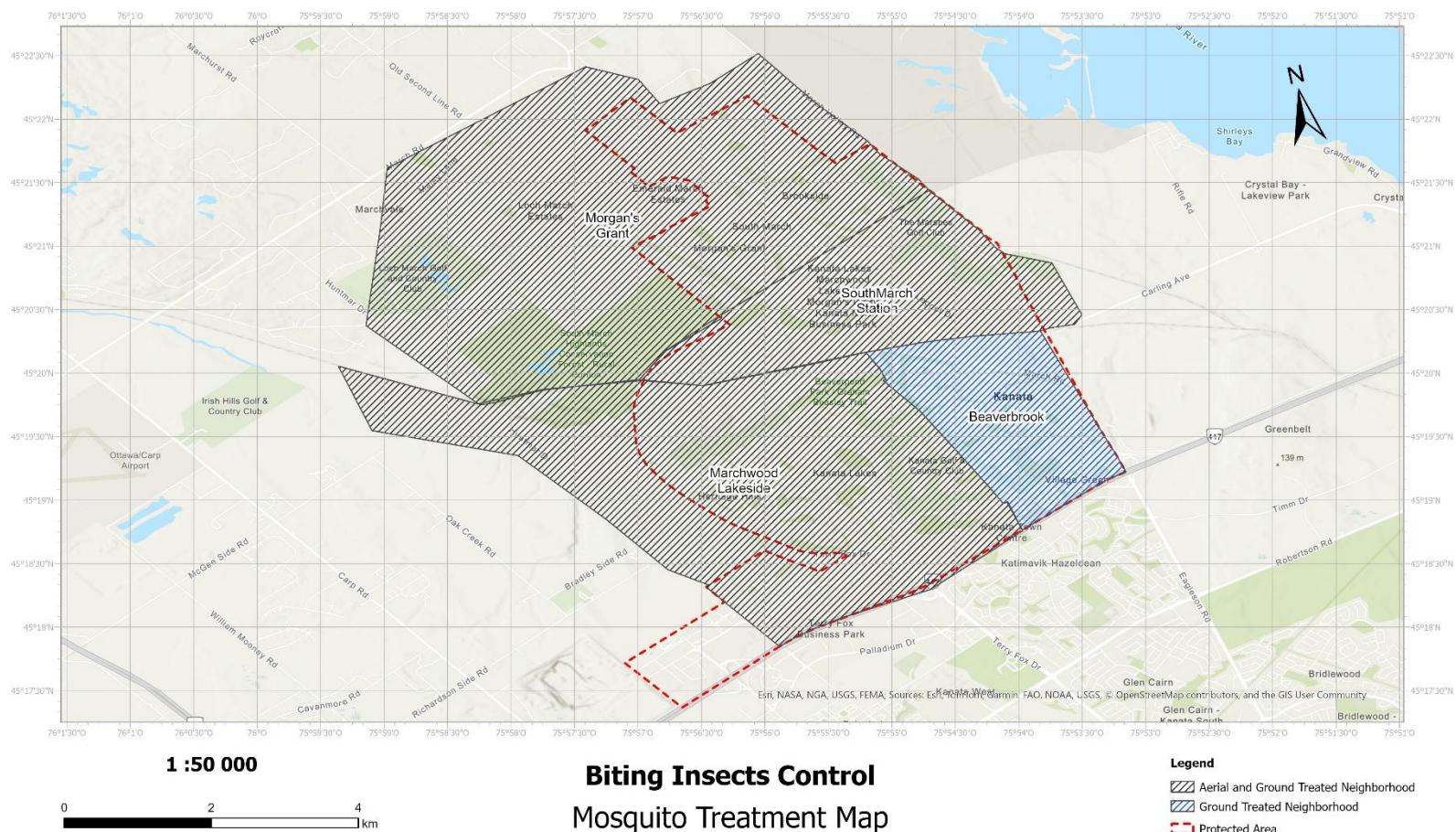

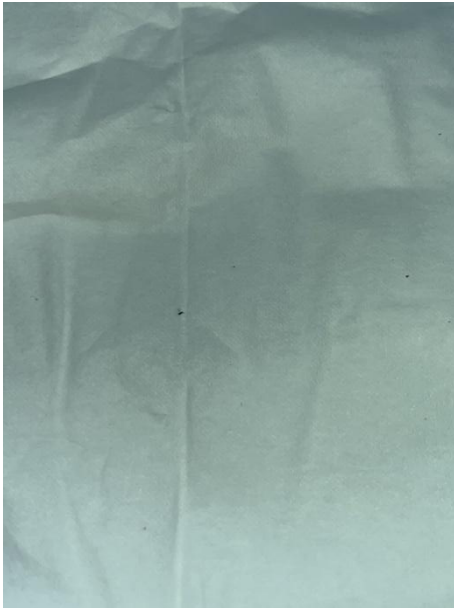

Request's details: Resident reported severe mosquito nuisance preventing normal use of their backyard and requested an inspection and follow-up.

Action taken: An email confirming receipt of the request was sent, explaining the current seasonal conditions contributing to increased mosquito activity. An inspection of the resident's property and the wooded area behind it was conducted the same day to assess larval breeding sites and determine if additional larval control measures were needed. The coordinator also suggested a nuisance test to evaluate the situation against the program's target thresholds.

FORECAST

Forecast for next week (July 12 to July 18):

We anticipate potential, highly localized larval hatching in response to last week's rainfall. Field teams will prioritize monitoring key areas to confirm if emergence is possible.
