Weekly report – August 2 to August 8, 2026

MONITORING and WEATHER

Accumulation of water: Between 66 and 80 mm of rain was observed during this period.

Date of precipitation: August 2, 3, 6 and 8.

Significant rainfall was recorded in the ward following the precipitation received over the previous weekend. Accumulated rainfall across the territory was substantial and led to another major larval hatching.

Water levels in the Carp River reached levels comparable to those observed in spring for the second time this summer. A slow and gradual decline was noted during the final days covered by this report.

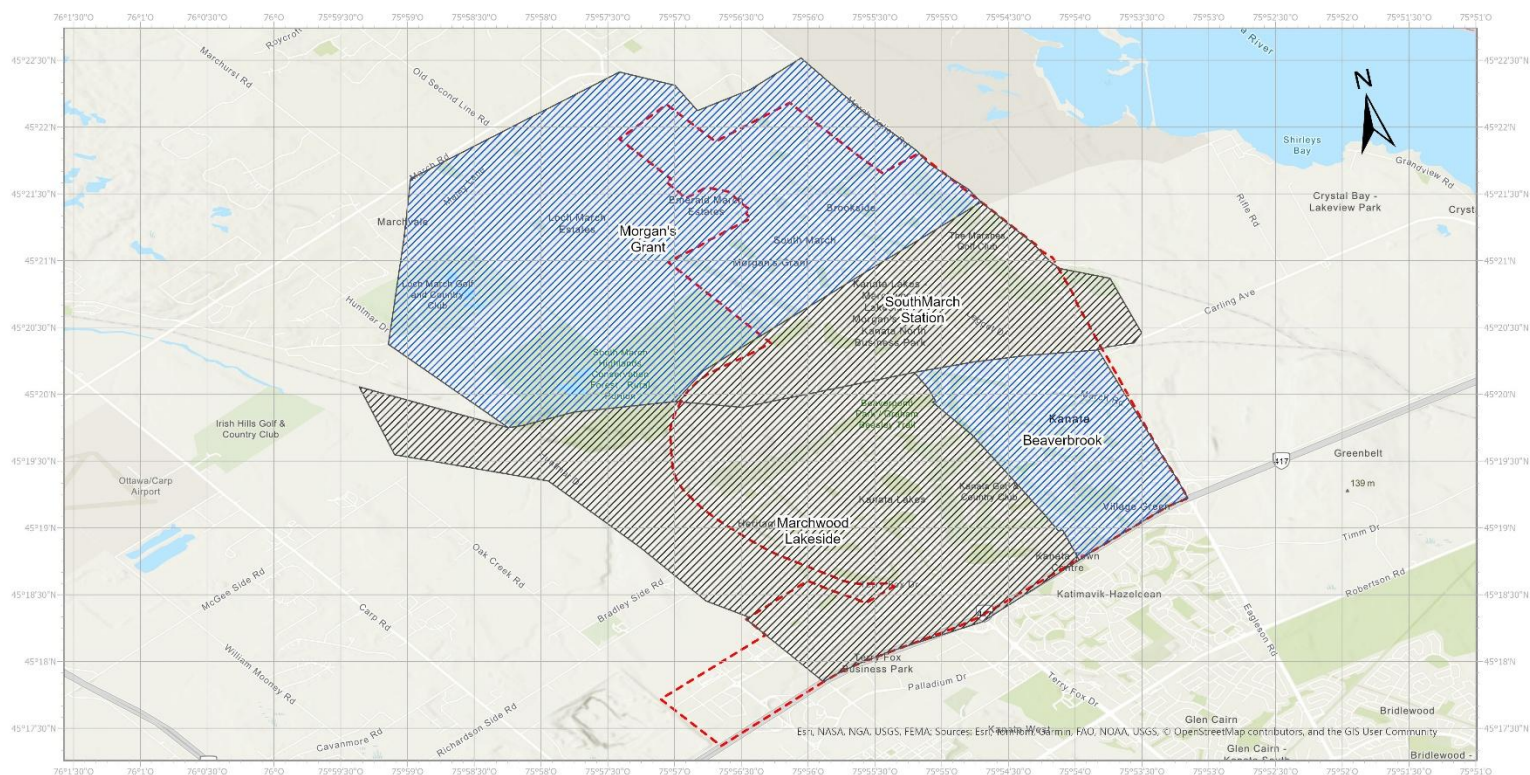

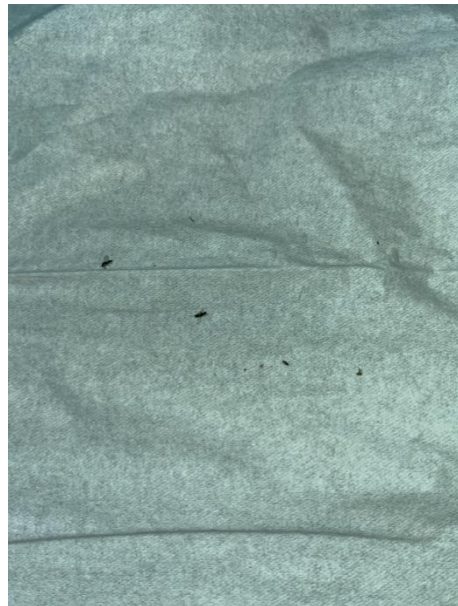
